

State Health Improvement Plan (SHIP) 2020-2024

The next SHIP will be moving farther upstream than the current SHIP, with increased emphasis on the social determinants of health. The SHIP will also expand the role of cross-sector partnerships within the Oregon Health Authority (OHA). The SHIP is the vehicle by which any agency, community or person concerned about community health can engage and align priorities for collective impact.

The following priorities were finalized after the SHIP Steering Committee reviewed feedback from more than 2,500 people gathered through online surveys and other events led by community-based organizations. The priorities for the 2020-2024 SHIP are:

- Institutional bias
- Adversity, trauma and toxic stress
- Economic drivers of health (including issues related to housing, living wage, food security and transportation)
- Access to equitable preventive health care
- Behavioral health (including mental health and substance use)
